

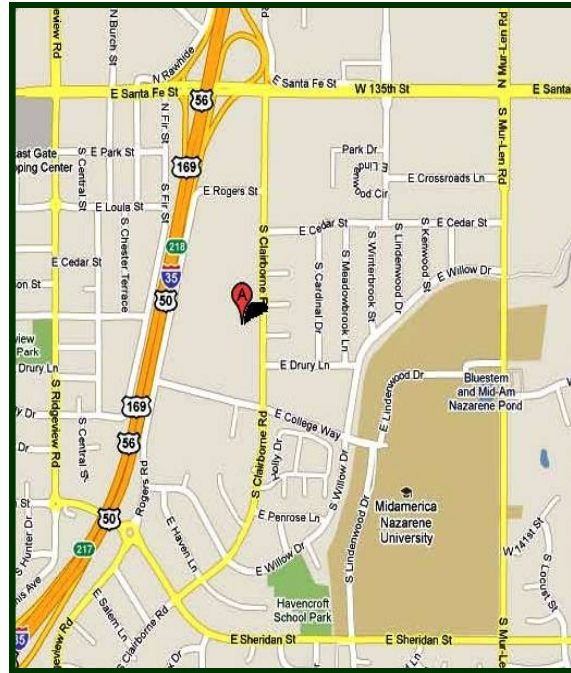
LifeLine is part of Christian Family Services
